THE ORIGINS OF THE BELVÉDÈRE RESIDENTS' PLATFORM

In October 2023, Dyana came up with the idea of setting up a residents' platform. Together with Jan Bierhoff (De Sphinxtuin), the establishment of such a platform has been discussed with district director Erwin Gerardu of the municipality of Maastricht since January 2024. After this, residents of Cielo (Brigitte van Wijmen and Victor van Itersen), Gustav (Matthieu Vermin) and Amonet (Alex van Breemen) joined the initiators.

ROAD WORK

Due to the road works at the Maagdendries, it feels for a moment as if Lindenkruijs and Sphinxkwartier are being split, but we will soon get a beautiful street with lots of greenery in return.

Road works from June to October 2024

From Monday 3 June to Thursday 4 July, work will be carried out on the Maagdendries and the Lindenkruijs. After the construction holiday, work will start on Achter de Barakken from August 12.

The work will last until October 2024. There is always one lane available for car and bus traffic. The entrances to houses and parking garages remain accessible. When asphaltting is in progress, parking garages are temporarily unavailable. Residents are still being informed about this.

The Maagdendries will have a central reservation with a number of tall, narrow trees, so that buses can pass easily. Due to the new road design with a central reservation, it is expected that motorists will better adhere to the maximum speed of 30 km/h. The zebra crossing at the Andriespoort returns to the same place.

Why choose a Roof Flower Meadow?

Petrification is a problem in many cities in South Limburg. It causes heat stress, rainwater has difficulty penetrating the ground, which causes flooding and it is bad for biodiversity.



A roof flower meadow is not just a green roof. It is a specially selected flower mixture of up to 40 native or local plant species that are suitable for the roof. This means that it has a high ecological value and is therefore good for our insects and birds. It is actually an improved version of a standard sedum roof.

In the summer it cools the environment and thus combats heat stress. It absorbs rainwater and thus prevents flooding. Moreover, it is good for preserving your roofing. And of course it looks beautiful too! Especially if you get a green roof together with the neighbors.

Get a green roof and get to 480 euro discount

The municipality of Maastricht and CNME want to work with you to make the neighborhood greener. Green roofs are a good idea for this. With green roofs we make our living environment more pleasant, cooler and more resistant to heat stress and flooding.

Do you like to use the flat roof of your house or shed for this? If you place a roof flower meadow on your roof through this promotion, you can receive the first 480 euros for free!

Until September 1, 2024, residents of the municipality of Maastricht can register with CNME for this promotion.

What does it cost me?

A roof flower meadow (material, transport and construction) costs €80 per m². You will receive the first €480 as a gift. This means that the first 6 m² per address are free.

Calculation example:

- If you have a roof of 6 m² or less, you pay nothing.
- If you have a roof of 20 m², then the first 6 m² free. The remaining 14 m² will cost you €80/m². This means that you still pay 14 x €80 = €1120,- incl. VAT.

You pay 50% after approval of your roof and 50% after construction.
